At a glance


- **NEW:** Completely new side loader
- **NEW:** Smooth, modern body design
- **NEW:** Large-volume trough compactor
- **NEW:** Close mounted lifter and small envelope for minimal lateral kick-out and to accommodate containers of up to 3.2 m³
- Manoeuvrable: 28 m³ on a 4,000 mm wheelbase
- Side loader on EURO 6 chassis

Features

- **NEW:** The new body is lighter than the previous model, and the smooth walls make for an ideal advertising space.
- **NEW:** The trough compactor is formed from two separate modules, the loading frame and the loading piston. Both modules can be replaced individually if the need arises, saving on costs and on resources.
- Cleaning work on the compactor can be reduced to a minimum: The trough compactor no longer leaves any space for cavities where dirt can collect.
- The drive cylinders for the loading piston are outside of the trough compactor and are easily accessible.
- Large volume loading: A big advantage when it comes to emptying many 1.1 m³ containers one after the other and large 3.2 m³ container

- A compaction cycle takes about 13 seconds: Compaction stroke 7.5 seconds and return stroke 5.5 seconds.
- Lifter: The tried and trusted C1100 lifter with enlarged opening angle of the container clamp, for secure placement of the container. And mounted close-in as an added feature.
- **Emptying bins:** Harmonised with the loading piston for uniform filling of the body.
- **Stability:** Two tilt cylinders ensure safety in the emptying position.
